More than hundred women are getting vocational training in this centre and this number is increasing day by day. Three female instructors are imparting vocational training in this centre in 3 shifts from 10 am to 5 pm.



Women of this area are taking full advantage of this vocational training centre and this course is very fruitful for these poor and destitute women. By the passage of time, number of women is increasing and more machines and raw material is required to accommodate additional learners.
